Manuscripts should be submitted in camera-ready format and should not exceed 12 pages, including figures and tables (see <a href="http://www.isvc.net">http://www.isvc.net</a> for details). All papers accepted will appear in the symposium proceedings which will be published by Springer-Verlag in the Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS) series.
